

## 25% more beneficiaries

The insecure situation in the middle East has affected locals. As a result, families, unaccompanied children, youth and singles flee from their countries. They are forced to look for a safer place to live. Along with old KYCLOS' beneficiaries who were mostly from Afghanistan, Iran, Syria, Somalia and Pakistan, Palestinians and Egyptians have become our new applicants. War, poverty and environmental disasters increase the number of people's movement. Therefore, in 2024 we provided services in 25-30% more refugees and immigrants than last year.


### “Light your candle”

## Collaborations

### Hellenic Open University

This year KYCLOS was asked by the Hellenic Open University to accept master students to do their teaching practice within its' context. New professionals get trained in teaching the Greek language to foreigners by following KYCLOS' methodology which is established through the long experience in working in the integration of refugees.



### Ilion Municipality

Our beneficiaries struggle to make a life in Greece. Along with working and learning Greek they claimed they needed to have moments of fun. Ilion Municipality was kind enough to provide KYCLOS' beneficiaries with a football court, where they play football matches!



### IB students of private schools

IB students that are sensible towards people in need, volunteer to provide help to KYCLOS' beneficiaries in the context of their school obligation for social assistance. Through their help, we created the cooking book with recipes from the countries of refugees, the KYCLOS' Christmas card for 2024 and audiovisual material presenting KYCLOS' work.



- to **find funding** to **hire** two new facilitators for all activities of KYCLOS and **enrich** the existing program.




## The HIGHLIGHT of 2024

Some of them were illiterate. Some of them were used to write from the right side of the page to the left. Some of them didn't know that the latin alphabet existed. But, they did not stop when they reached the basic knowledge. They did not stop after the first year. They had a vision of obtaining an official acknowledgment. It took them three or four years. They struggled together with their teachers and their classmates.

Without a doubt the highlight of 2024 is when two of our students managed to obtain the certificate of the Greek language (level A2 and B1). It is the official certificate provided by the Greek government to those that pass the official exam.
